

EXEMPTIONS FROM REQUIRED INSTRUCTION

If the religious belief and teaching of a student or his or her parents or guardian are contrary to the content of a school subject, or to any part of a school activity, the student may be exempt from participation.

To request an exemption, the parent or guardian must present a written request for exemption to the principal, stating the conflict that is involved.

If a student is unable to participate in a physical education class, he or she may present a statement from a physician stating the reason for the student's inability to participate. The statement or request for exemption will be presented to the principal.

Exemptions from required instruction will not excuse a pupil from the total unit requirement for graduation.
